Full Signalization of N. Capitol St., Quincy Pl. and Lincoln Rd. Intersection – Ward 5

Dear Chairperson Thomas:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D. C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- **Full Signalization of N. Capitol St., Quincy Pl. and Lincoln Rd. Intersection – Ward 5**

Currently, the intersection of N. Capitol St, Quincy Pl. and Lincoln Rd. is partially signalized. Lincoln Rd. approaches at the intersection are controlled by hybrid form of traffic control (flashing signal/ STOP control). Flashing operation is also present in the southbound direction of N. Capitol St. Moreover, four existing crosswalks at the intersection are not signalized. In the interest of promoting safe and efficient movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic through and in the vicinity of the intersection, a traffic operational analysis was carried out recently. The analysis has determined the need for complete signalization of the intersection.

In this plan, access from southbound Lincoln Rd. onto N. Capitol Street will be established directly at the intersection level by eliminating the current median break on N. Capitol St. In that respect, the island on the south-east corner will be modified to create more space for pedestrians.
